

Dress Code

Adults who work with children young people should ensure they take care to ensure they are dressed appropriately for the tasks and the work they undertake.

Those who dress in a manner which could be considered as inappropriate could render themselves vulnerable to criticism or allegations.

- The uniform consists of a polo shirt worn with a skirt or trousers of own choice.
- Uniforms must be worn at all times. The nursery will provide all staff with 2 polo shirts and 1 hooded jacket annually.
- It is the staff responsibility to keep uniforms clean and presentable
- Trousers, skirts, jeans and knee length shorts can be worn while working in the setting.
- Sensible footwear is required, heels no higher than 1` or open toes is not allowed.
- Long hair must be kept tied back at all times.
- Nail varnish must not be worn {clear only}
- Rings, earrings and any other jewellery must be kept to a minimum
- Tattoo`s must be covered
- Body piercing to be covered
